

While we hope for a peaceful demonstration today, we urge you to avoid getting directly involved.

If you do witness any incidents, please consider the following actions, provided it is safe to do so:

- Take a note of the place and time.
- Keep a note of any identifying details, such as names or badge numbers, and details of other witnesses.
- Make a detailed note, as soon as you can, of what you saw.
- Record footage of any incidents on your mobile phone, if possible and if safe to do so.

a right to:

- Free legal advice at the police station.
- Consult with a solicitor in private.
- Have someone notified that you are in custody.
- Read the PACE Code of Practice C, which lists all your rights.
- Have an appropriate adult called to the police station if you are under 17 or mentally vulnerable.
- An interpreter if you do not speak English.
- Contact your Embassy if you are a foreign national.
